What We're Learning Next



Reading: Next week we will continue to build reading stamina, as well as learning how to write a reading response. We will also review how to read with a partner. AKS: Ask and answer such questions as who, what, where, when, why, and how to demonstrate understanding of key details in a text (CCGPS) (2LA_A2012-1/ELACC2RLI)

Writing: Every author needs great ideas to write about. We will be working on coming up with lists of ideas that the students can write about. We call these seed ideas. AKS: Write narratives in which they recount a well-elaborated event or short sequence of events, include details to describe actions, thoughts, and feelings, use temporal words to signal event order, and provide a sense of closure (CCGPS) (2LA_D2012 24/ELACC2W3)

Math: We are continuing to set up our Math Workshop in our classroom. This includes setting routines, learning center rotations and learning to use our Math Journals. We will also begin our Graphing Unit. AKS: Create a picture graph and a bar graph (with single-unit scale) to represent a data set with up to four categories (CCGPS) (2MA_C2012-27/MCC2.MD.10)

Science: We are learning about animal's life cycles. Please review these vocabulary words at home: reproduce, offspring, adult, chrysalis, cocoon, pupa, life cycle, and larva. Look for a study guide coming home at the end of next week. Our assessment will be on Tuesday, August 27th. AKS: investigate the life cycles of different organisms to understand the disposity of life (GPS) (2SC_D2007-13)
